The base map depicts the area just before it was published in 1843, for example, not shown are East Downs Road (with land for it sold in 1845); Bowdon Downs Congregational Church (completed in 1848) and St Margaret's Church (completed by 1855). However, this is a later electrotype edition dating from 1872, which superimposes the train stations and railway lines which had been built since the original map had been made, for example the Manchester South Junction and Altrincham Railway in 1849, extended by the Cheshire Midland Railway in 1862.
