ALTRINCHAM,

WITH AGDEN, ASHLEY, BAGULEY, BOLLINGTON, BOWDON, CARRINGTON, DUNHAM MASSEY, HALE, HEATLEY, LYMM, PARTINGTON, PEEL CAUSEWAY, RINGWAY, STATHAM, TIMPERLEY, WARBURTON AND NEIGHBOURHOODS.

ALTRINCHAM is a respectable and clean market town, and gives its name to the poor law union of which it forms a part. It is in the parish of Bowdon, hundred of Bucklow, 30 miles N.E. from Chester, 7 N. from Knutsford, and 8 S.S.W. from Manchester; situated on the line of the South Junction railway, in a dry and remarkably healthy locality; whilst the views on the high grounds about Bowden are extensive and pleasing. Dunham Park is the finest seat in the neighbourhood, but there are many handsome residences that border the town, the gardens of which display great taste. The Duke of Bridgewater's canal passes by the Broadheath entrance to the town, on which packets constantly ply between Manchester, Runcorn and Liverpool, for the conveyance of goods. The Unicorn Hotel has a very commodious bowling green, and affords every accommodation for commercial men. The labouring class are principally occupied in agricultural and building operations, and the many market gardens in the district supply the Manchester markets with a large amount of produce. Hamon de Massey, in the time of Edward I. granted many privileges to the inhabitants of the town; amongst others a guild mercatory, or Society of Free Traffic, with freedom from tolls throughout the barony, &c. A court leet is held by the Earl of Stamford who is lord of the manor; the chief officer is styled "mayor," but does not exercise any magisterial functions. The Market Hall and Town Hall were erected in 1849, by the late Earl of Stamford and Warrington. It is a brick structure with stone facings, and has a clock and bell turret, in the upper part of which is a lantern with pillars, and arches supporting a copula. The assembly room measures 66 feet by 30 feet. The new Market Hall is a fine building, situated at the top of Shaw's lane, the principal entrance facing Market street. Petty sessions are held twice a month, and the Commissioners of Inland Revenue meet at stated periods. Altrincham is included in the seventh circuit of towns under the County Court Acts, for the recovery of debts not exceeding £50. St. George's Church is of brick, erected by subscription in 1799; it corresponds in neatness with the town, which is marked by an air of quiet comfort and respectability. The living of Altrincham is in the gift of the vicar of Bowdon. St. John's Church, Ashley road, is a handsome and commodious building, erected by public subscription in 1866, the site of which was given by the

late Earl of Stamford and Warrington. It is built of stone, with tower and spire. The other places of worship, with their localities and ministers, will be found in a subsequent page. A British school was erected near Ashley road in 1860, at a cost of £2,500, obtained by subscription; and there are schools for instructing the humbler classes of children, and several superior private seminaries, as well as a first-class grammar school, in Barrington road. The Altrincham and Bowdon Literary Institution was established in 1847. The library contains upwards of 2,000 volumes, and there is a spacious newsroom, supplied with the leading provincial and London papers. There is also a large hall for holding public meetings, a smaller one over the newsroom, and several rooms for art and other classes. Lloyd's Hospital and Dispensary was erected by public subscription in 1853, at a cost of £600, of which sum Mrs. Lloyd contributed £300, and at her death bequeathed £1,000 for its benefit. A new public park, called Stamford Park, 16 acres in extent, and formerly known as Hale Moss, was opened October 23rd, 1880, and is intended to meet the wants of the working classes in the immediate neighbourhood. The land was given by the late Earl of Stamford and Warrington, and has been tastefully laid out by the Local Board, at a cost of between £4,000 and £5,000. The market is held on Tuesday, and the fairs April 29th, August 5th, and November 22nd, for cattle, toys, &c. Acreage, 657.

Bowdon is a township, village, and the head of an extensive and populous parish. The village is delightfully situated, for the most part on an elevated site, about a mile from Altrincham. A short distance to the west is the extensive and beautiful park of Dunham, which we shall notice under the township of that name. Numerous tasteful villas, occupied chiefly by the merchants and wealthy tradesmen of Manchester, adorn the neighbourhood. The parish church of St. Mary, said to have existed prior to the Conquest, was partially razed in 1858, and a new one, of much larger dimensions, has been erected. It consists of nave, chancel, side aisles, and transepts. The portions of the late edifice which had been preserved have been restored, and the carved oak ceilings of the side aisles of the old church are retained. The style of architecture is of the perpendicular or third pointed period. The entire cost of erection was £14,120. The church stands on a considerable elevation, and from

its tower the views are extensive and highly picturesque, the land being in a fine state of cultivation, and richly embellished with wood. Several handsome monuments adorn the church, those to members of the Warrington family may be particularly noticed. The living of Bowdon is a vicarage, in the gift of the Bishop of Chester. A grammar school was founded here in 1600, and the school house was re-built in 1670, and again in 1806, but it is now merged in the parochial schools. There are some well endowed schools, and others for gratuitous instruction in different parts of the parish, which are noticed in their place in the Directory. The soil throughout the parish is principally of a light and sandy nature, peculiarly favourable to the growth of the potato, large quantities of which were formerly produced.

PEEL CAUSEWAY, a station on the Cheshire Midland railway, is about three-quarters of a mile south-east from Bowdon. It is a rapidly improving neighbourhood, the opening of the railway having had the effect of stimulating building.

DUNHAM MASSEY is a chapelry, township, and village, in Bowdon parish, the village being about two miles south-west from Altrincham, and separated from that of Bowdon by Dunham Park, which, with the mansion, are objects of great attraction in this neighbourhood. The Hall, re-built in 1730, is a large brick building, of quadrangular form. The parks, which abound with fine lofty timber, furnish pasturage for numerous deer. The grounds are much frequented by parties from Manchester and its neighbourhood in the summer, and afford a delightful recreation to the pent up citizen. The late Earl of Stamford and Warrington erected a new church in 1855; it is dedicated to St. Margaret. The building is of stone, and the style of architecture of the 15th century. The same nobleman also granted a site in the village whereon a neat Gothic church was erected in 1864, at a cost of £1,500, raised by the public; the living is a curacy attached to Bowdon. The township is 3,470 acres in extent, and comprises the village of DUNHAM, and the hamlets of WOODHOUSES, SINDERLAND, and OLDFIELD.

BAGULEY, a township and straggling village in the parish of Bowdon, is $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles N.E. from Altrincham. Thomas W. Tatton, Esq., is lord of the manor. The places of worship are Baptist and Independent chapels. Baguley Hall, now a farm house, is a fine old building of oak and wicker work; in the interior are some good specimens of old oak carving.

TIMPERLEY is a township, chapelry, and village, likewise in the parish of Bowdon, 2 miles N.E. from Altrincham, and forms part of the Dunham estates. Timperley Hall is a handsome building, and its situation remarkably pleasant. In September, 1849, was opened a new church for this district, which was enlarged in 1865; it is a handsome edifice of stone, dedicated to Christ. The Wesleyans have also a chapel here. A line of railway from Stockport passes through Timperley, and is connected with the Warrington line, which lessens the distance to Liverpool. Acreage, 1,628.

HALE is a township in Bowdon parish, adjoining Altrincham, from which town the hamlet of HALE BARN is distant about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles S.E. The Earl of Stamford is lord of the manor. At RINGWAY, a hamlet about a mile further from Altrincham, is a chapel of ease, erected in 1720, by Lord Crewe; the living is a perpetual curacy, of which Lord Egerton is the patron. The township contains 3,679 acres.

ASHLEY is a township and village in Bowdon parish, between 2 and 3 miles S. from Altrincham, situated on the verge of Tatton Park. There is a station on the Cheshire Midland line here. Lord Egerton is lord of the manor

Ashley Hall, an ancient manorial mansion, is worthy of notice as containing portraits of certain influential gentlemen of the county, who, in 1715, formed a club favourable to the designs of the Pretender; Thomas Assheton, Esq. the then owner of the manor, deciding, however, against the expediency of joining the standard of revolt, the enterprise was abandoned. A neat little church and school-room were erected by the late Lord Egerton in the village; the living is a curacy, attached to Bowdon. A chapel for Wesleyan Methodists is in the township.

BOLLINGTON is a township partly in the parish of Bowdon, but chiefly in that of Rostherne, about 2 miles S.W. from Bowdon. The Earl of Stamford is lord of the manor. The chapel, dedicated to the Holy Trinity, is a neat Gothic edifice, erected in 1854; the living is a curacy, annexed to Rostherne. Acreage 631.

AGDEN is a small township adjoining Bollington, partly in the parish of Bowdon, and partly in that of Rostherne, 4 miles S.W. from Bowdon. Sir John L. Chetwode, Bart. is lord of the manor. Acreage, 520.

CARRINGTON is a township, village, and chapelry in the parish of Bowdon, about 5 miles N.W. from Altrincham, possessed by the Earl of Stamford, who also presents to the living, which is a perpetual curacy. The chapel of ease of St. George is a small brick edifice, erected in 1750, by George, Earl of Stamford and Warrington. A National school adjoins the chapel. The township comprises 2,333 acres.

PARTINGTON is a township and village, in the parish of Bowdon, about 5 miles N.W. from Altrincham. There are in the township places of worship for Wesleyan and Primitive Methodists and Independents. There are 803 acres in the township.

WARBURTON is a parish and village, the latter about 5 miles W. from Altrincham. The estates are possessed by the Warburtons, of Arley Hall, who hold courts leet and baron for the manor, and present to the living of the parish. The church of St. Werburgh, which stands on the banks of the Mersey, is one of early date, and of very ancient appearance; the living is a perpetual curacy annexed to the rectory of Lymm. Some years since, three stone coffins, lying on the north side of the church, were opened, and in one was found a human skeleton of extraordinary size. The coffins bore marks of great age, and are supposed to have been the resting place of some members of the Premonstratensian establishment which existed here. The acreage of the parish is 1,747.

LYMM is a parish and village in the same hundred as Altrincham, the village being about 6 miles W. from that town, and about the same distance N. from Warrington. The parish church of St. Mary the Virgin has been re-built upon an enlarged plan, and the expense defrayed by subscriptions. The living is a rectory, in the gift of the Warburton and Leigh families. A neat chapel for Baptists has been erected by Thomas Ridgway, Esq. Lymm Hall, commanding the bay windows of the principal entrance room having some fine specimens of stained glass. In the village is an ancient cross, the lowest steps of which are cut in the solid rock. Oughttrington Hall is a handsome residence, commanding fine prospects of the country around. Near to this mansion there has been erected a large and handsome church. A Free Grammar school, which stands near the church, was endowed in 1698, by Sir George Warburton and William Domville, Esq. A parochial school was built and endowed in 1863, by Mr. Thomas Jackson. The Independents have a handsome chapel, and the Wesleyan and Primitive Methodists have each a place of worship in the village. The parish, which includes the hamlets of HEATLEY and ST. MARTIN, comprises 4,284 acres.
