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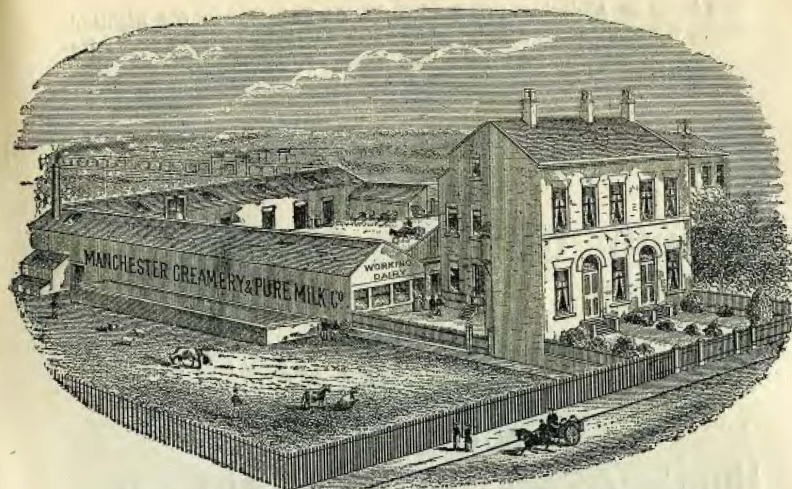

ALTRINCHAM AND BOWDON,  
DUNHAM MASSEY, HALE,  
TIMPERLEY,  
BAGULEY AND ASHLEY.

The town of Altrincham, with its wealthy and populous suburb, Bowdon, is one of the most important towns and districts in Mid-Cheshire, and contains, together with its closely contiguous district, a population of nearly 35,000 persons. Altrincham is one of the oldest and most prosperous towns in the county, and the adjoining suburb of Bowdon is the chosen and favourite residence of one of the most influential communities in England; and both are within twenty minutes' railway journey of the half-million of population congregated in the City and Borough of Manchester and Salford. Their growth and progress during the last 25 years is scarcely paralleled in the North of England. Altrincham is one of the principal gateways to the whole of the County Palatine of Chester. It has its Magistrates' Court of wide authority; its County Court, which has a jurisdiction extending to and embracing the townships of Altrincham, Bowdon, Sale, Knutsford, Lymm, Hale, Ashley, Mobberley, Wilmslow, Baguley, Timperley, Dunham Massey, Ashton-upon-Mersey, and other adjacent seats of population; also its Local Board of Health and Board of Guardians, being the most important and populous town in the Union.

The population of Altrincham in 1871 was 8,478, and in 1881, 11,249; of Bowdon, in 1871, 2,262, and in 1881, 2,559.

The last few years have seen the erection in this neighbourhood of the Altrincham Market (which is held on



Tuesdays); that fine specimen of architectural grandeur, the Wesleyan Chapel at Bowdon, whose stately tower serves as a landmark for half-a-score of miles round; the Conservative Club, the New Station, and Post Office, and the making of the Stamford Park. Within ten minutes' walk of the Altrincham Central station is Dunham Park, for many years the residence of its owner, the late Lord Stamford. The stately beauty of the park, with its magnificent timber, renders it one of the most favoured attractions in this portion of Cheshire. Altrincham enjoys the distinction of being a borough, and is one of the few unreformed corporations existing in Cheshire. The mayor and the usual officers are annually elected, the dignity of the mayoralty being maintained out of a fund of some three hundred pounds a year, accruing from land bequeathed for the purpose by an ancestor of Lord Stamford, the lord of the manor.

Bowdon Parish Church is built on a considerable elevation. The old church, erected anterior to the Conquest, was partially razed in 1858, and the present much larger edifice erected. The portions of the old church which have been preserved have been restored, notably the carved oak ceilings of the side aisles. In the church are several handsome monuments and tablets principally to the members of the Stamford family. The living is a vicarage in the gift of the Bishop of Chester.

## DUNHAM MASSEY.

Dunham Massey, which adjoins Altrincham and Bowdon, Ashton-upon-Mersey and Carrington, is one of the most extensive townships in this district. Here are a large number of the fine residences of the princely Manchester merchants. Here is the fine baronial residence, Dunham Hall, for many years the Cheshire residences of the Earls of Stamford. The glories of this magnificent park, with its stately mansion, have a fame far beyond the district in which they are situated. Dunham Park is a favourite holiday resort of the residents in the manufacturing towns within a radius of twenty miles.

There are several places of worship in the township, the most notable being St. Margaret's Church, one of the finest

ecclesiastical edifices in the county. The church, which stands on one of the most commanding situations in the district, is a tribute to the munificence of the Stamford family.

The church of St. Mark at Dunham Town is a small structure; the other places of worship being the Wesleyan Chapel at Sinderland Green, and the Primitive Methodist Chapel at Woodhouses, Dunham. The nearest railway stations are Dunham Massey and Broadheath, on the London and North-Western Railway, and Altrincham station, on the Bowdon line. The assistant overseer and collector of rates is Mr. James Fletcher, Woodhouses, Dunham Massey. The township is well drained, and the more populous part lighted. The population is 1,977; the ratable value, £28,715.

## HALE.

The township of Hale adjoins Altrincham. There has been a large increase in the number of houses in the township during the last few years. The places of worship are the Ringway Church, of which the Rev. H. A. Hignett is the vicar; the Hale Unitarian Chapel, the minister of which is the Rev. J. C. Hirst; and the Wesleyan Mission Room, off Hale Road.

The township affords some of the finest scenery to be found in the county. Castle Mill and the charming woods in the neighbourhood are much visited by pleasure parties during the summer. The more populous part of the township is well drained.

There are two Post Offices in the township—one at Peel Causeway, the other one at Hale Barns, the letters being despatched from the former at 7.45, and from the latter at 6.30.

The township is comprised in the Altrincham Union, and has a ratable value of £17,570. The population is 2,221.

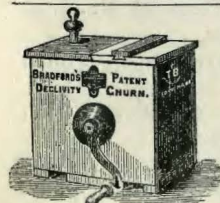

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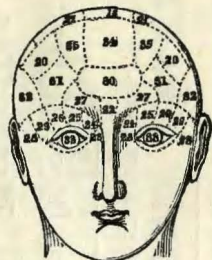
